"You matter", "You are worthy", and "You are safe here".

Moving to a new city, school, and home can be a daunting experience for anyone yet alone a young child. Welcoming our youth with open arms and an empathetic heart is what truly makes their stay here so special.

The moment our youth accept that they are worthy of all the joys that come with their childhood is the moment that they begin to bloom and heal from the traumatic experiences that they have endured. Each day our staff aim to provide them with life-changing experiences and services, from something as small as learning how to tie their shoes to learning how to submit a college application. Each day is tailored to their unique needs, regardless of their age, with great care and oversight.

Over the past year we have seen an increased need in the community to serve homeless youth on the cusp of adult independence - many times having been displaced during their senior year of high school. With the implementation of our Transitional Living Program (TLP), which supports youth ages 15 to 20, we have been able to assist youth reach their high school graduation goals and transition to college. This program meets each youth where they are in their journey to adulthood and can support them with services for 12 to 18 months. Our youth need your support and encouragement as they focus on their education, their health, and their healing.
